BARKER BARKS The Canadian listings were tough as I'm not familiar with them—thanks to Dennis Snell, Leonard Paone & Jack West. Baseball card collectors owe a particular debt to Mel Bailey who published the 1962 set of Omaha Dodgers cards. Speaking of publishers, Chris McCann has made up an analysis sheet of PX2, the 1962 Salada Baseball coins, and G. Lionel Carter has mimeographed an account of the Carters' 1963 life, but forgot to mention that wife Irma sent in a bunch of cards collected on their travels for listing. Jeff Morey, who's due for Ft Dix NJ on Feb 1, mailed the 1962 Syracuse BB Club Xmas card showing the All-Time Syracuse Players. Ray Medieros has settled at 5324 Greybull, Cheyenne, Wyoming—says son Robbie is much better than he in the Spanish climate—just noted Ray Anton Medieros of Oakland, Calif played one game for the Cincy Reds in 1945—any connection? Always believed our Ray was from Fall River, Mass.

MORE THANKS to Fred Sticha, Tom Vanno, Dave Brower, Bill White & Bruce Yeko for listings. Tony Robertson sent in a President milk bottle cap from Bordens of Houston. Seems funny that, with one exception, no card dealer or issuer has ever voluntarily sent in information, no make that two exceptions, were Jim Martino of Fleers and Leonard Paone the Vancouver dealer.

CANADA Where exactly the same card is issued by Topps in the U.S. and O-Pee-Chee in Canada, no Canadian listing is given because there would be no way to distinguish them when they clearly state "Printed in U.S.A." While on the subject of Topps, they are selling penny wrappers marked "Trading Card and Bubble Gum", inserting cards of various series 2 or 3 years old. And does anyone know whether R412, 1954-55 Hockey was sold in the U.S., in Canada, or both? It's been assumed this was a U.S. issue, but could that be wrong? It never was sold in St. Louis for sure. The St Lawrence Starch Co each year issues a list of Bee Hive N.H.L. Hockey Pictures (FC32, 5X7) of 100 to 130 names, adding and dropping names each year, and presumably keeping the same picture of those retained on the list. Note FC34, Brooke Bond, has different backs, mostly blue with some black printing for their U.S. issue, and mostly black with some red printing for the Canadian. Also Blue Ribbon is not shown on the U.S cards, just Red Rose only. Altho seen on the Wild Flower cards only, most likely both backs exist for Series No.1 (Songbirds of North America), Series No.2 (Animals of North America) Series No.3 (Wild Flowers of North America), and Series No.4 (Birds of North America). These are the only issues known; the 2nd Songbirds Series (FC34-2) was evidently an error- also note the exact titles as listed above, all with albums

ALSO FRED BAUM'S CORRECT ADDRESS FOR BURDICK PLAQUE DONATIONS IS 848 EAST 12th ST BROOKLYN 30 NY. The 21st St address in the Dec 1963 BULLETIN WAS WRONG. (Caught by Sam Stark)

MISC. CARDS. The W571 Seattle Baseball Club listing above is odd in that the cards definitely were issued with popcorn at the ballpark- but there is no identification to separate them from the earlier small Seattle Club issues, so they are W571. By the way, could the earlier cards have been issued in popcorn too? Some weren't as they came in sheets of 8 or 10 to the sheet. It's rumored that there was an American Maid Bread baseball issue. Forgot to mention that R726-2 Torrone Perugina animal cards were seen in Mexico. Something new to collect. are the mats of pictures used by newspapers- distributed by feature services; they have a 3-D effect. Fleers premiums 1963 of baseball pennants appear indistinguishable from the other BB pennants listed as BF6, except for the new Expansion Teams-someone evidently sells these same felt pennants to different firms as premiums. There was a temptation to list the sports color cards printed by Scheible Press of Rochester (possibly Scheible is Trench of Buffalo too?) as a separate issue; however, they are all covered under the team listings- mighty good printing!

[This section from Bulletin #161, NOT from Barker notes.] BARKER'S BARKING AGAIN Here's a real opportunity. Just see your nearest coin dealer. A medal (silver) commemorating the 1962 Dodger Stadium opening- the issue was limited to 3500 pieces at only \$30.00 each. By comparison the medal of Ty Cobb at \$5.00 would be a steal. (Thanks to Ed Curtis). Pres Orem, though out of collecting, sent in the Giants of Science- and says he's thinking of publishing BB History Book No.2. There's nothing I want more than his new book, which will cover the 1887-90 period of the Goodwin BB issue, plus many other years. OTHER CONTRIBUTORS were Blazina with the Pitt Sweet-Cleans, Kenworthy- Oregon Scenes, the new American Caramel series from both Hendrick and Egan the same week. A most remarkable 40 year old issue- must have been issued sparingly. Thanks to Medieros, Andersen, McLean, Thing, Morey and others. It appears that Amer. Caramel used old pictures in the 1927 set, an old habit of theirs. So far only one card (Wertz) has turned up in the Liber Indians (Cleve) set. Note two Hot Rod sets by Topps and DonRuss. Topps has reached their limit, I hope, with Ugly Stickers- yet the kids like them (my grandson says "Doc" is the scarce one).

PLAYING CARD decks are out of Pro Football stars (beautiful) and John F. Kennedy, and politics entered the card field with Topps Johnson-Goldwater sets. (Baseball collectors—there are BB cards in some of these odd sets) Did you [know] Harry Riconda (3b) hit .243 in 243 games with 5 teams from 1923 to 1930? Harry Kenworthy reports seeing two T210 (red borders BB) the size of T3 cards but with greenish borders and "Old Mill Cigarettes" at lower left. Phila Gum, like Topps, has put their football cards in the supermarkets with—out gum as "Trading Card Features".

TOLEDO MUD HENS had a set of 20 postcards like McCarthy's with blank backs in '65- Chuck Cregar's promotion. Visitors to the Houston Astrodome may purchase postcards of the place, a magazine-book telling about it all, and probably many other souvenirs. Note the Minn-Twins issued a game "Focus on the Twins" with cards showing pics of the players, symbols of all AL teams and a few odds and ends. Tra-Cards keep adding to their series, a few new ones each year. These cards are issued on chrome post card stock, and they are "pretty as a postcard".

COKE BOTTLECAPS, collected by some, were not used by the St Louis branch in 1964, but they joined in in '65- note each city issues a different [at this point the text is cut off at the bottom of the page. I have deleted another sentence dealing with continental postcards.] Wonder why Topps didn't put their name on the "Outer Limits" set? Frank O'Connell of Wash. D.C. found a frankfurter card of Rizzuto, but who issued it? and when? (NO, not Stahl-Mayer). Got a letter from Evanston with "Dr. C. Arter" on the return address, who dat? XMAS CARD from David Brewer featured Currier & Ives, from Art Macoskey a hand-lettered one featuring a quote from the T112 Toasts Series. Wheaties had a NFL stamp album like their BB one. A Little Known Fact- Russell Lyon, who caught 7 games in '44 for Cleveland, was born in Ball Ground, Ga. Hamms Brewers issued a '65 Minn Twinns team picture in colors. Exhibit put out a Beatle set, natch, and admirers of Volpe's Dodger and Twin baseball pictures can now get all 4 Beatles by Volpe- send \$1.98 to Hollywood House, 6425 Hollywood Blvd, Hollywood. (Limited to 3 sets per order). No crowding please. (PS I'm neither a Beetle or a Volpe fan myself). END OF THE LINE for Ut4, the White Sox picture ticket stubs, no pictures in 1965. A new book "Bubble Gum and Kipling", stories of Santa Fe' by Tom Mayer, \$3.95 from Viking Press. "Traditional Games of England, Scotland, Ireland", 2 volumes for \$5 from Dover, should have something on the history of baseball and its predecessors. "The New Yorker" reported that a chewing-gum association had been formed in Japan, called "Gamu-Kamu-TO". Jim McLean found a 1904 cabinet photo set (printed on paper with a card backing, 4 X 5-1/2 picture of bb players on 5-1/2 X 7 card) - set of 18, issuer unknown. Paper comics are down to 1-3/4 X 2-1/2 (Fleer's Bubbly Bill,
