



ODDS & ENDS In St Louis, all the storekeepers know gum cards as "flips," and so does everybody else. In Memphis, are they "flicks"? Don Russ has recognized this officially by telling how to play "flickers" on the wrappers of Green Hornet Gum. As we all know, you either match fronts and backs, or flip them at a wall or line, just like pennies, but this is the first mention of these games by issuers, we believe. Topps distributed The Monkees flip books without gum, and possibly the Monsters flip books too- but they'll go into "R" as no one would look for Topps in "W". Topps is also selling buttons without gum as well. Speaking of The Monkees, Batman, and the Beatles, sometimes we wonder if anyone really cares about all the series that have been issued on these boys during the past few years. Decks of playing cards have shown up in the supermarket toy racks featuring Green Hornet, Man from U.N.C.L.E. (& others ??) We're not sure whether the Art Masterpieces with Beam's Choice Whiskey are just on the bottle- imagine having to collect an entire series by emptying all those decanters? Don Russ has another first in their SuperHeros, captions picking fun at the heros. On Card #11, Capt America says he got his plane for 362 books of stamps. Girl on #26 says, "I'm sorry I'm tied up this evening" to Daredevil, and she sure was tied up.

WON'T List "Flying Things", a Topps toy, 12 or 24 from Japan. Recipe cards without pictures, such as given with Baker's chocolate. Pictures in tumblers- Union Oil had 12 Volpe Dodgers in 1965, and Sun Oil 48 baseball players in 1966. And of course single cards. Examples are the 1965 Mickey Mantle by Phillies Cigars, 1964 Falstaff 4X6 of Diz Dean & Reese, a 1965 Hamilton Furs of Mantle & Maris (6X9), and Musial on the box of Hawthorne baseball (Montgomery Ward).

BIG LEAGUE BOOKS BASEBALL CARDS - this term seems to have confused some. They are these sets of 5X7 paper issues in sets of 12, normally sold at the major league baseball parks. They were published by "Big League Books" of New Canaan Conn, and could be purchased direct. As mentioned last time the publisher was killed, but someone is putting some of them out anyway.

The St Louis Cardinals were missed on this year's Coke baseball set, presumably because Busch is in the beer business. Somehow bottlecaps don't seem to be too collectable, but so many are doing it, so we'll continue to list them.

CATALOGING Sugar sacks appear to have become collected by a separate group, so we'll probably list no more, the milk bottlecaps are still "in". All the groceries and gasoline companies are featuring contests, but most of their paper items do not appear to fit in here. What if they were all issuing card sets? A set of cards from WWII (miniature posters) was found by Bro. O'Connell, issued by "Associated"— we're assuming this is gasoline, but is it? The Cleveland Indians have a novel yearbook for 1967 consisting of loose 6X9 paper pictures of the players with their records on the back, all in a folder. The Cardinals started it in 1966, with Cincy and the Pirates following in '67— an 11X17 sheet of player pictures with autographs folded once, just like the club newspapers. Folger is the first coffee company in years to issue cards, circular animals & birds to fit in their
