TOBACCO CARDS ISSUED SINCE 1900. In some cases it is difficult to determine whether a set belong in this list or in the lists of older sets (before 1900), which will appear in future Bulletins. Appearance of the cards themselves is often sufficient evidence but, experience in buying and sorting old collections will generally decide the question. Collections formed around 1890 do not contain any of the cards listed herewith and, likewise, collections formed around 1910 - 1915 seldom contain any of the older cards.

Lists of the two periods cannot well be made in the same form. For these 20th Century Cards a straight alphabetical listing (with minor variations) has been judged most advisable. Details as given should be sufficient to identify any cards. Of course this list is not complete but any omissions will probably be minor sets of local distribution. I will be glad to see a sample of any cards which do not seem to be listed. The will be returned promptly and the dat .

A few collectors thought that this list would give the names of each individual card. That would be highly desirable but, such a list would be impossible to form completely and, even to give the available names would require a booklet of many pages. However, complete card lists of many sets are available and may be borrowed from me. If desired, inquire as to sets wanted and send return postage. There may some delay in sending and, such lists should be kept only a few days.

ADVERTISING. A collector asks to purchase space in the next Bulletin in which to list his individual wants. There is no objection to this but, it will be necessary to charge Two (2φ) cents per line (6 lines per inch) to cover the extra cost. Fifty copies of this Bulletin will be printed. About half will be sent out immediately and half

reserved for future orders.

PRICES. I have been glad to have my price suggestions receive general approval. The individual prices in this Bulletin are intended to reflect demand and supply as I have observed it. I shall be glad to have further comments. It has been suggested that full sets of any kind are worth a premium. It is seldom that such a full set is available. As a rule, collectors have to build up full sets a little at a time. The suggestion seems reasonable but I would not care to set any premium at this time. Condition of the Cards would have to be considered. Probably in most cases inferior condition of some cards will offset any premium that completeness might justify.

DIRECTORY. A few collectors who have subscribed to the Bulletins do not, for various reasons, wish to be listed in the Directory. Consequently, this list would not reach the size which it should and, does
