Old Photo Actresses.

19th Century photograph cards probably never will have the popularity of the colored designs, but their star is ascending as collectors realize, that after all, these are genuine cigarette cards and, moreover, are real likenesses of the people portrayed. They constitute a true gallery of the stage of the 1880-1900 period that quite likely has no equal. A collection may be high in quality without them, but it hardly will be high in quantity as a normal large collection of 19th tobacco inserts will be approximately half photo actresses. Here is a rough listing of the quantified as now in the Metropolitan collection:

These figures are for the actresses only. Addition of other photo type cards would bring the total to more than one half of the 19th collection. With two or three exceptions, there is no data on the total quantity in any series. While a few of the above groups seem to be nearing completion, most of them are a mere beginning and the possible total quantity by all issuers must be staggering - probably several times the total in this tabulation.

In the small size, the Kinneys include the Type I of #246 (which are 1 5/8 width and not 1" as misprinted). The #245 are considered as one series, those with horizontal printed backs being the last group issued, as will be mentioned later.

Dukes can be divided into 8 groups: 1) Cross Cut with brand, title and number in the design. 2) Cross Cut with brand in design, title and number in bottom margin. 3) Cross Cut with all data in margin. 4) Cameo with brand in design, title and number in margin. 5) Cameo with all data in margin. 6) Dukes Cigarettes with brand in design, title and number in margin. 7) Dukes with all data in margin. 8) Title at bottom and with back inscription.

Allen and Ginter #45 are of 7 types: 1) Ordinary Virginia Brights. 2) Brand in top corner black label. 3) With brown margins. 4) Four small pictures per card. 5) Larger 1 3/4x 3 size. 6) With Dixie cigarettes. 7) With back inscriptions. A further group would be the Little Beauties #60.

National (Admiral) are usually classed in 3 groups: 1) With brown margins. 2) Regular type. 3) With brand name in shaded panel at bottom. Actually, the third type is some sort of reproduction but because of the similarity to actual prints they are usually grouped together as has been done in these figures. It should be noted that in all these

divisions there may be cards both with and without name of actress.

Kimballs have the plain Kimball backs and the printed Vanity Fair backs. The Kinneys with horizontal backs and the Duke, A&G, and K Kimball with printed backs are probably the identical group of photos made in 1893 after all these firms became branches of the original American Tobacco Co. This also accounts for the similar setup for the Ships #50 and other series. the Ships photos really set the date as those showing Columbus' fleet probably show the replicas of these vessels made for the Columbian Exposition of '93.

Goodwines come in the three brands, with the Temple Bar exceedingly scarce. The "No brands" are also mostly "no names" and cannot be positively identified with any issuer; the only one of any certainty being Allen & Ginter's Old Dominion cigarettes as indicated by the advertising cards #g109.

In the large cards, Duke #150 and the Gail & Ax are probably id to mostly the same designs although it is not possible to match all of set them, especially the large five inch size in Gail & Ax. the "Others" in both sizes, are series in which the collection shows 25 or less cards. the dividing line between small and large is usually placed at 3 inches, anything over that being considered large. Square cards would be "large" even if slightly under 3 inches.
